FEATURED GAME - LISBOA

Lisboa is the latest game by Vital Lacerda, designer of the games *Kanban, Vinhos*, and *The Gallerist*. The theme of the game is the reconstruction of Lisbon, Portugal after the great earthquake of 1755. It is a city building game with economic and political elements. It is played in rounds, with all players having one turn in each round. Through the play of cards, players schedule hearings to get character favors that involve commerce, construction, and openings. Players needs to manage influence, construction licenses, store permits, church power, workers, and money.

As in all games by Vital Lacerda, *Lisboa* challenges players to make multiple interconnected decisions that will benefit their position. This game seems to give players the ability to impact other players' turns and options more significantly that his other designs, with the possible exception of *Kanban*. It has received generally positive reviews from the gaming community.
